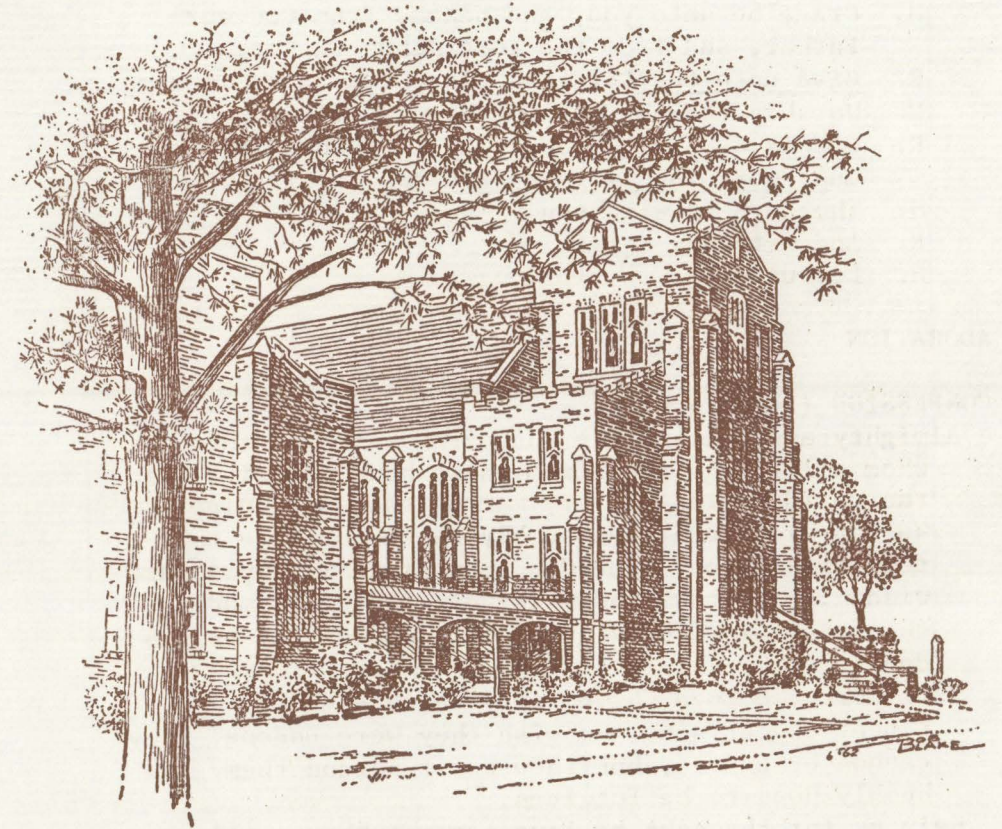

HYMN FOR THE MONTH

The Hymnbook, No. 441

"Pleasant Are Thy Courts Above"

Harry F. Lyte, a Scotsman, known only for several hymns, namely: "Abide With Me," "Praise My Soul, the King of Heaven," and "Jesus, I My Cross Have Taken," was a priest in the Anglican Evangelical Church in Ireland. Because of ill health and adversities he moved from church to church and ended his career in a harbor town on the coast of England. Here he gathered a Sunday School of nearly 800 children in days when schools were few, and trained some 70 teachers.

For this parish he wrote all the hymns that made him known to the world around. "Hymns for his little ones, hymns for his hardy fishermen and hymns for sufferers like himself." The hymn we are hearing today for the offertory is from a collection called "The Spirit of the Psalms," and is a paraphrase of the 84th Psalm.

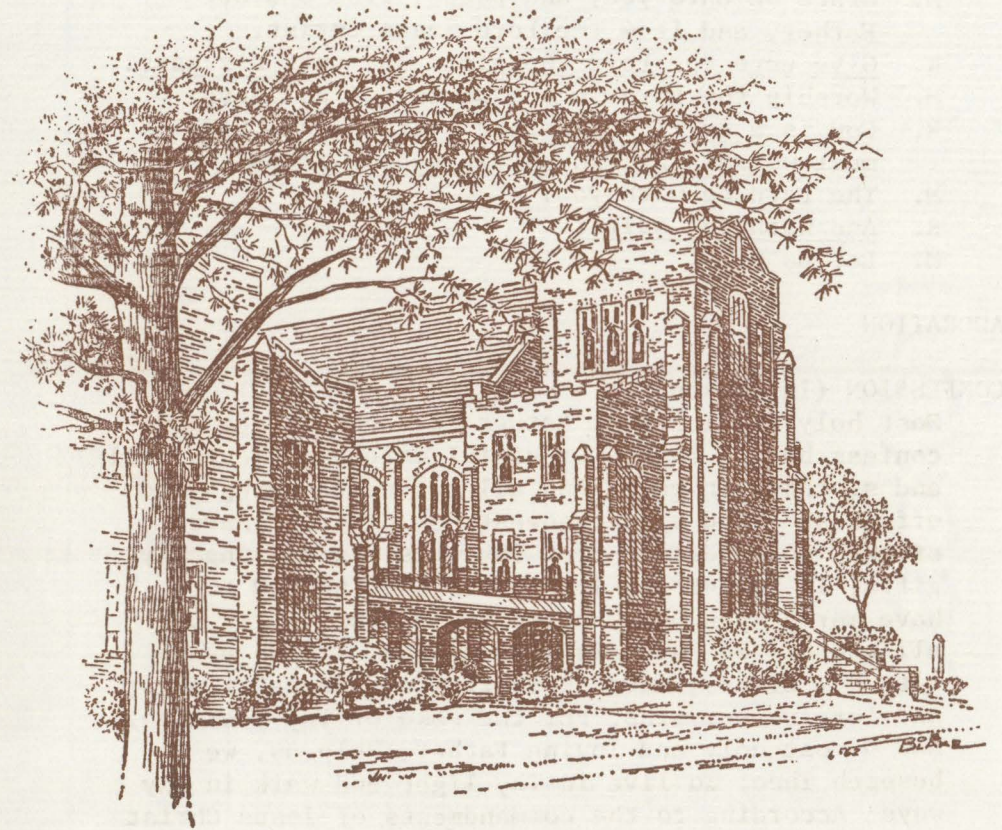
