## CHRISMONS

*Study the Chrismons on display in the Narthex.*

The ones today are:

1) *TRI QUETRA and CIRCLE*  
The Trinity in Eternity  
The Eternal Triune  
The Eternal One!

2) *CROWN*  
A symbol of the Kingship of our Lord, Jesus Christ, THE KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

3) *EIGHT POINTED STAR*  
This pre-Christian figure, drawn without removing the tool from the surface, was adopted by Christians as a "concealed" Chrismon during the Roman persecutions. In the crossing lines, Chi's (X), the first letter of Christ in Greek, and crosses were apparent to the initiate. It is good to recall that it was not always easy to be a Christian, even in name.
