THE PARISH BANNER

The first Parish in Durham was founded in 1880 by Bishop Cheshire who was in Deacon's orders at the time.

Bishop Cheshire's arms were three fusils on a cross bar. Upon these arms are imposed the symbols of the Patron, St. Philip, Deacon, who is known chiefly for baptising the Ethiopian eunuch. His symbols are the DALMATIC, the vestment peculiar to a deacon, and the SHELL, symbol of baptism.

Philip the Deacon is known also as Philip the Evangelist to distinguish him from Philip the Apostle who was one of the Twelve. This Philip was one of Seven Deacons whose appointment is recorded in Acts 6. Concerned to proclaim the Gospel to the Gentiles, he was successful in winning over the Samaritans from belief in the sorceries of Simon Magus to Christianity (Acts 8:9-13). After the conversion and baptism of the Ethiopian eunuch (Acts 8:26-39) Philip went on a missionary tour from Ashdod northwards. He settled at Caesarea, with his four daughters who were noted for their prophetic powers, and here he gave hospitality to St. Paul (Acts 21:8). Uncertainty shrouds the latter years of Philip. One tradition makes him Bishop of Tralles, in Lydia.

The goal of Christian Education is an attempt to stimulate and enable the women of our parish to study more creatively as a means of enabling them to grow in their capacity for worship and service.

Toward this end we have adopted as our course of study for the coming year a consideration of the life and work of eight (8) outstanding men of our Diocese. They include bishops, priests, and one layman, and their lives span more than 200 years. We believe that a study of these men will be a source of inspiration for us all, as well as adding to our knowledge of the Diocese.

CHRISTIAN MINISTRIES AND COLLEGE WORK

Five parishes, St. Andrew's, St. Joseph's, St. Luke's, St. Philip's, and St. Stephen's, cooperate in the work done at the Episcopal Student Center at Duke University. A committee is formed of the five representatives with one member serving as chairman. The parishes cooperate in serving a breakfast honoring the freshmen in September and a Christmas buffet supper in December. Also, this Committee attempts to keep in touch with members of St. Philip's attending colleges. Suggestions for additional ways of service are always welcome.

CHRISTIAN SOCIAL RELATIONS

Christian Social Relations is just that -- the relations to (or in) society. On a personal level this means ALL our activities, ALL our relations. As the Church, or Episcopal Churchwomen, it means our relations with society in the local community as well as in the world. Envisioning such a relationship, the Christian Social Relations Committee is closely bound to the Missions Committee and at St. Philip's we are cooperating as closely as possible with that group. Also, the Christian Social Relations of the Episcopal Churchwomen will be represented on the Center City Church Council and any projects that Council undertakes will have priority in our planning. At present, the main projects are Meals on Wheels and volunteer driving. Mrs. Dana Ripley is Chairman of the volunteer driving which includes driving the elderly to doctors, hospitals and marketing.

The semi-annual Material Ingatherings (clothing drives) will continue to be sponsored jointly by the

Christian Social Relations and Missions, assisting Mrs. Daniel Pearson, Chairman of Material Aid. Meanwhile, we shall seek wider means of witnessing as Christian Women in the Society in which we live.

CHURCH PERIODICALS

The purpose of this National Church organization is to supply reading material to hospitals, prisons, rehabilitation homes, schools, etc.

To provide through contributions to the Book Fund, for the purchase of books or magazines specifically requested by theological students, missions, and church workers at home and abroad.

The Chapter secretaries will receive these items or they can be left at the Parish House. Subscriptions to Church periodicals will also be taken by this committee.

Usually the first Sunday in October is designated as Church Periodical Sunday throughout the Episcopal Church.

Participation in corporate communions, Quiet Days, Diocesan Retreats and all worship services in our Church will be encouraged. It is also hoped that we may all develop a new awareness of the values of private devotions, family prayer and how essential reading is to spiritual growth.
