There is an interesting passage that has blessed me greatly in the last few days in Zephaniah Chapter Three. The passage answers the above question. Space would not allow a lengthy exposition, but a few thoughts are in order.

We can boldly face the future when we know the attitude and positioning of our Lord toward His children. Note verse 17. Five statements are powerful. "The Lord thy God in the midst of thee is mighty." Yes, He is. "He will save." He has and He will. "He will rejoice over the with joy!" The verse here means He is dancing over us. He is thrilled about the attitude of His children in the passage. He is so thrilled that He "He will rest in his love." The dances. Lord knows and is comfortable in His love to His children. "He will joy over us with singing." He sings over us in the bad times to comfort and in other times to encourage and motivate.

With this kind of understanding of God the believer is able to sing, (vs. 14) shout (vs. 14), rejoice (vs. 14), and to work faithfully—vs. 16—"Let not thine hands be slack." He is able to "Lift His Head" and move forward into ministry. (Our theme for 2007). Lord Grant It!
