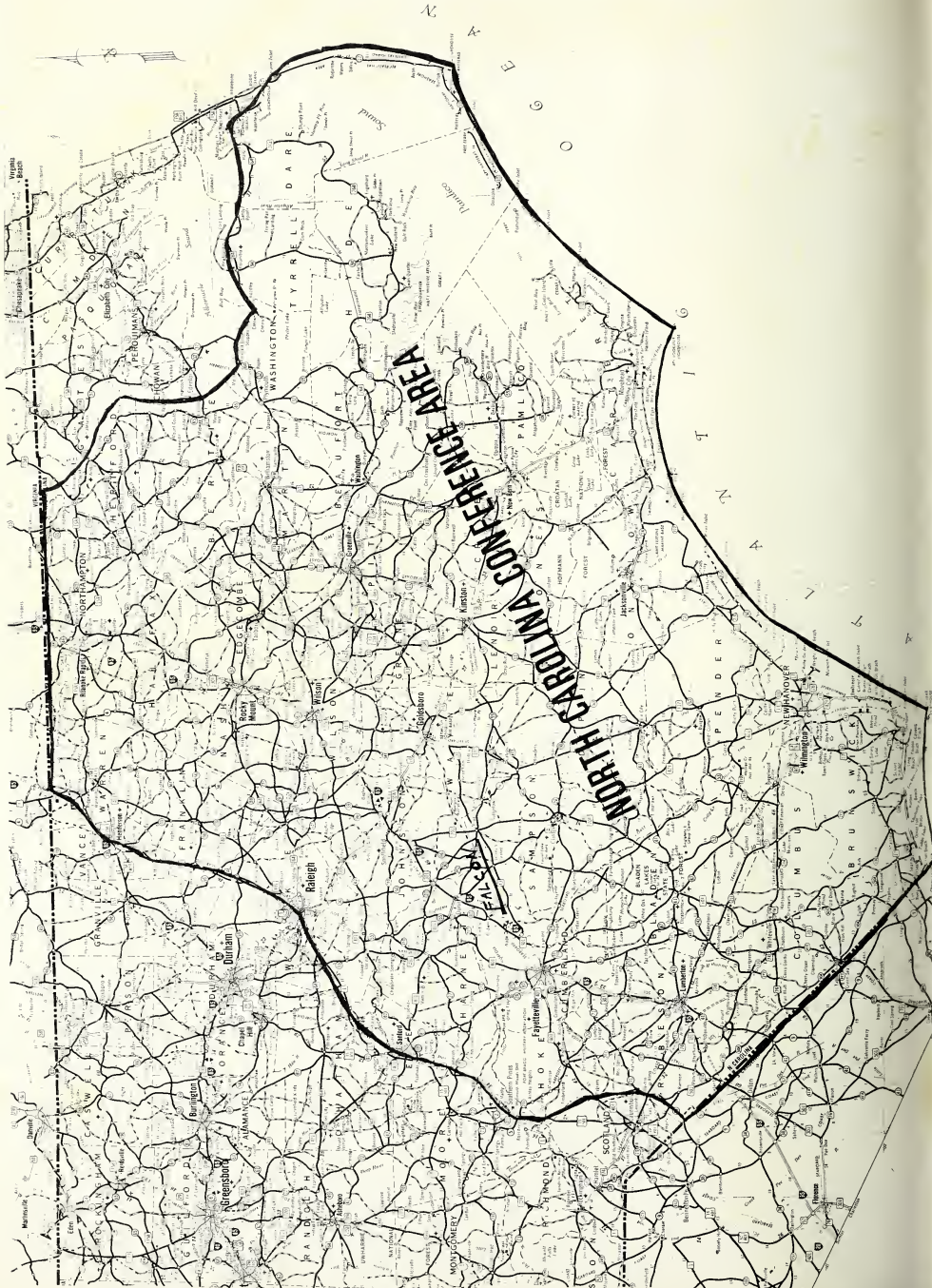

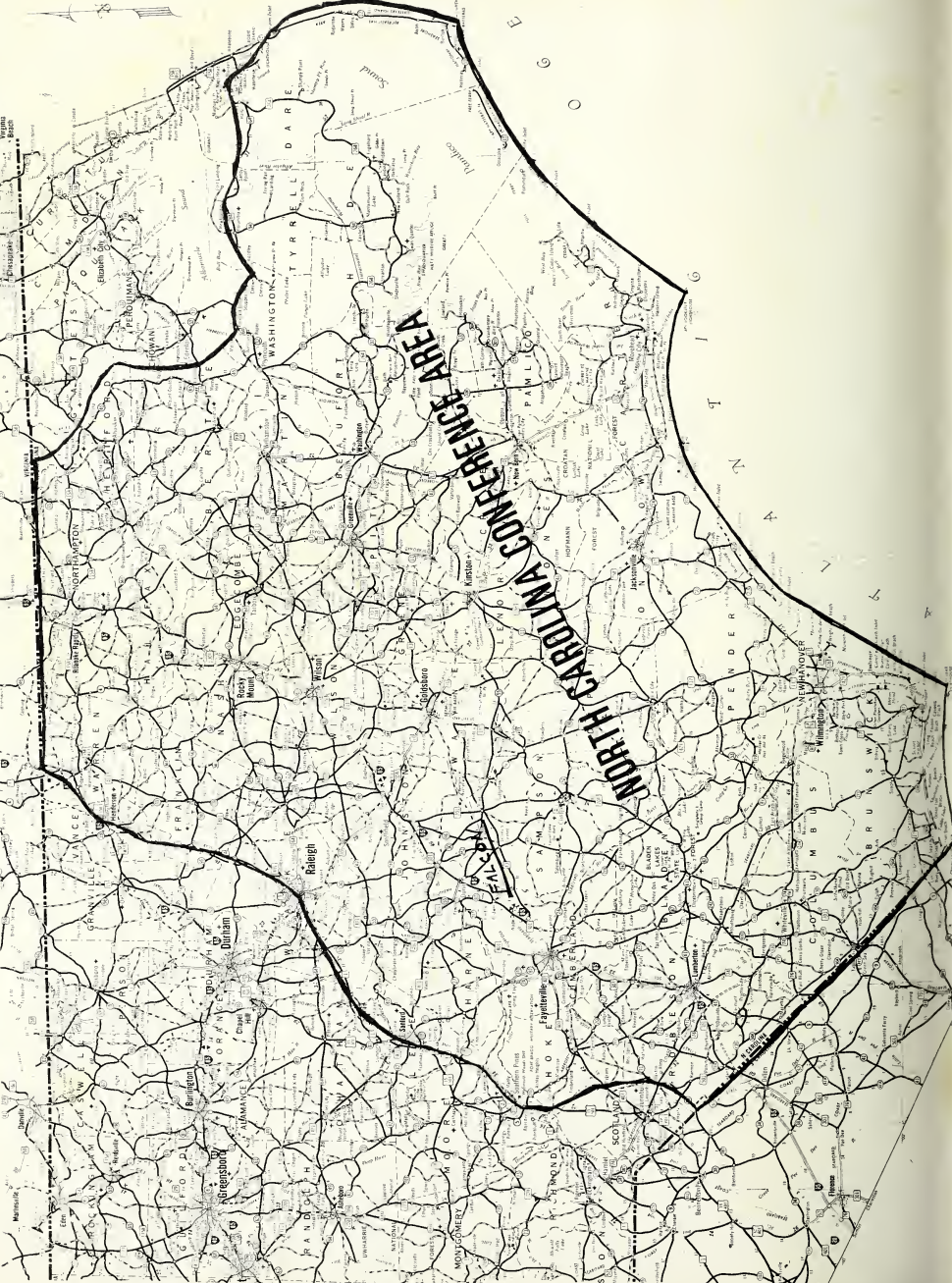
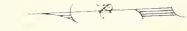

REPORT OF CONFERENCE SUPERINTENDENT

THE STATE OF THE NORTH CAROLINA CONFERENCE

The state of the North Carolina Conference for the year 1973 is very good. This is our first report since we changed from the fiscal year to the calendar year. Therefore, we will have to begin with January 1, 1973.

In this report you will see the greatest increase we have ever shown. This was made possible through the leadership of first, the Holy Spirit, our ministers, local church and the continued effort of keeping the program before the people.

For the first time that I can remember, the North Carolina Conference has lived up to its name. We are often referred to as the largest conference, and we are. We have often been referred to as the largest, but not doing our part toward the General Program financially. Well! I am happy to report for the year 1973, the largest conference gave more to the General Program than any other conference. For this I am very thankful. First, because it is our responsibility; secondly, when we give, God pours out His blessings upon us. The following report will give progress of each department.

Christian Education

The Christian Education Department will again show a continued growth. Reverend Wiley T. Clark, director, and our Christian Education Board have worked untiringly to make this report possible. We have seen through the years that the Sunday School and Lifeliners Departments continue to be the greatest source of growth for our church.

It takes much prayer, planning, and time for this program. For there are youth camps, Teen Talent, rallies, candy sales, work shops, membership drives, and conventions to plan for and direct. Each year we feel that this is the best yet. But God, through His divine leadership, continues to bless.

Several years ago the National Census was, that the Sunday Schools are gradually fading out and would soon be no more. But not so with the Sunday Schools of the Pentecostal Holiness Church and the North Carolina Conference. Thank God for Brother Clark and our Christian Education Board for keeping the need and value of both Sunday School and Lifeliners before this Conference.

Evangelism Department

There is so much that could be said about the Evangelism Department, its director, Reverend L. B. Collins, and Board. However, time and space will not permit. Reverend L. B. Collins will give a more detailed report, but may I mention some highlights.

This year through this department seven churches have received assistance, and in each we have seen God working. Fuquay-Varina for many years had been at a standstill. But today it is on the move. The old church has been sold, and four and a half acres of choice land purchased on Highway 401 just out of Fuquay. A new church program is underway. The church, Sunday School, Lifeliners, Woman's Auxilliary membership and attendance have increased to an all time high. Reverend Collins is the pastor of this church and I know he will not want to say so much about it himself, but will report on others.

The Evangelism Department is paying off. Small churches placed under this program do not remain small long. We need now about seven full time experienced ministers this year to place under the program. Pray about it. And if God leads, we can use you. May I express appreciation to everyone who gave of his time, means, and prayers for the support of the Evangelism Department.

Woman's Auxiliary

The Woman's Auxiliary, under the capable leadership of Mrs. Hollon Davenport and her board, have proven again the saying, "If you want a thing done, let the women become involved." Through their efforts the cafeteria now is simply beautiful. They first bought new drapes, then new carpet, and this year, new tables and chairs. This was made through the participation of each local Woman's Auxiliary doing its part. For such we say, "Thank you and God bless you."

This is only a small part of their labors in our conference. They also have rallies, workshops, retreats, conventions and special Conference-wide Woman's Auxiliary Day. In each church you can see the touch of the Woman's Auxiliary. Other than making the church more worshipful, these fine ladies promote the annual Harvest Train, visit the sick, shut-ins, carry trays, conduct prayer meetings and help win the lost to Christ. I have often wondered how the church got along before the organization of the W. A. I do not want to look back to see or try to remember. I look with great pride on what they are doing now, and can visualize a greater work in God's kingdom for them tomorrow.

Other Areas of Progress

This report would not be complete without saying something about the overall increase in various areas of the church. First, may I express appreciation to each for your faithful service in each department and assignment, for it takes everyone working together to make such a good report possible.

The annual Harvest Train reached an all time high this year. This conference alone gave \$42,318.73 cash and \$21,868.20 in commodities, a total of \$64,186.93. This shows real concern and love for our children. The World Missions Program has shown its greatest increase this year. Reverend Raymond Potter was appointed as conference director two years ago. One pastor from each district was appointed to serve with him and the conference superintendent to coordinate a program with the General Missions Department. Through conventions and mission rallies this year, you have made an increase of over \$30,000.00 to World Missions. This shows your love for our missionaries and for those who have never heard the Gospel. My appreciation is extended to Brother Potter and his committee on a job well done.

Gratitude to God

We know that progress is in each department because those involved "had a mind to work," for God only works through men. But the increase and blessings always come from God. To Him we give the praise.

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PROMOTIONAL CHRISTIAN EDUCATION CONVENTION
