- 8 Appointed the Clerk Treasurer and to superintend the printing of the minutes; to have 800 copies printed and distributed as usual.
- 9 Resolved that we now return thanks to God, the brethren, sisters and friends of this vicinity for their kindness during this session.
- 10 Resolved that we now adjourn to the time and place of our next meeting.
