Proceedings.

The Association met pursuant to adjournment of last year.

The Introductory Sermon was delivered by Elder H. B. Miller transient from the Washington Association from 4th chapter of Paul's letter to the Ephesians. "One Lord, one faith and One Baptism."

1 After a short intermission the messengers assembled in the church house and was called to order by singing and prayer by Elder C. C. Davis.

5 Called for transient or visiting brethren to seats with us, when the following came forward: Mountain, Elders W. R. Craft, M. B. Martin, and brothers M. B. Ham and Isham Wagoner; Washington, Elder H. B. Miller; Roaring River, Bro. L. W. Vannoy.

6 Authorized the Moderator to make all temporary appointments during the session.

Kilby.

8 Appointed a Committee on Finance as follows: Bros. C. J. Taylor, J. B. McMillan and T. J. Baldwin, who reported as follows to-wit:

Report of committee received and they discharged.

9 Appointed correspondents to sister Associations as follows: Washington, Elders T. H. Kilby, C. C. Davis and Bro. T. J. Baldwin; Silver Creek, Elders E. A. Long, J. A. Cave; New River, T. H. Kilby, Bro. C. J. Taylor; Mountain E. A. Long, T. H. Kilby; Fishers River, Elders J. H. Cave and Elisha Roup agreed to correspond with Kehukee, Bear Creek and Indian Creek by minutes; Roaring River, T. H. Kilby, W. R. Craft, E. A. Long, and Bro. C. J. Taylor.

10 Appointed a Committee of Arrangements as follows: Elders C. C. Davis, W. A. Choat, W. G. Shepherd, L. S. Jones and C. J. Taylor. with Moderator and Clerk correspondents and transients invited to seat with the committee.

11 Adjourned until 9 o'clock to-morrow morning; prayer by Eld. M. B. Martin; Elds. S. A. Greer and J. H. Cave preached at the stand to-day.

7 Our next Association to be held with the Pond Mountain Church, 15 miles north of Jefferson, N. C., commencing Friday before the 1st Sunday in Oct. 1903.

8 Appointed the Clerk Treasurer and to superintend the printing of the minutes; to have 800 copies printed and distributed as usual.

9 Resolved that we now return thanks to God, the brethren, sisters and friends of this vicinity for their kindness during this session.

10 Resolved that we now adjourn to the time and place of our next meeting.
