Dear Dr. Thompson:

There are certain items about which I wish to write you at this time.

First, upon the completion of the printing of the Wesleyan Theological Journal by the Pilgrim Press they sent to me, at my request, six copies of the Journal. It is my understanding that each member of the WTS receives one copy of the journal free, and that these journals sell at \$1.00 per copy. I am, therefore, sending to you herewith my personal check in the amount of \$5.00 to cover payment of the five extra Journals which I received. Please credit me accordingly. I incurred considerable personal expense in handling this editorial and printing project for the WTS, but I am happy to make this small contribution to the cause. I wish no remuneration for it.

Second, I note in your letter of May 17 that you have not received the \$100.00 from the NHA Executive Committee which was promised through Drs. Geiger and Kindschie toward the publication of this Journal, and that you have thus been unable to complete payment of the bill for the Journal to the Pilgrim Press. I do not understand this as I was informed that this item would be cared for at the NHA Convention at Dallas in April. Of course you cannot pay the bill without the money. However, the project was given to the Pilgrim Press with the approval of the Editorial Committee, Dr. Richard Taylor and Professor Merne Harris, and with the assurance that payment would be made promptly upon delivery of the Journal. It would seem to me that this is a business obligation that requires our immediate attention in accordance with the promises made.

Third, I sincerely regret that the Pilgrim Press attached the additional charge of \$28.00 + to the stated cost. Nothing had been said about such a charge by them until the bill was presented. Armor Páisker made some changes in the proofs, they say, but I have been unable to detect them. Also their man there made some incorrect transliterations of Groat words that had to be corrected.
