Dear Dr. Harris:

I trust the WTJ reached you in good shape at the NHA in Cleveland and that you had good success in distributing them.

I took 50 copies of the Journal to sell. I will of course pay the treasurer for these, except that I did have one copy sent to Dayton, one to Arnett and one to Ralph Thompson directly from the Pilgrim Press, and also one to you. The total bill came to \$659.89, or little more than half the figure quoted by most other printers. Then Eerdmans Publishing Company has paid Dr. Thompson \$55.00 for the WBC ad that appears in the Journal. Consequently the figures stand as follows for the 1,000 copies.
