Just a few items this morning while I am writing.

First, could you send to me at once a copy of your Treasurer's Report to the WTS Convention at Marion made up as it is on page 91 of the 1969 WTJ? I need this for the new 1970 WTJ and would like to have it just as soon as possible.

Second, please also send me the present WTS membership as it appears at the bottom of page 92 of the 1969 WTJ.

So far I have not been successful in getting anyone to veritype the 1970 Journal, and have no prospects at present. I have just this minute called a lady who works for Rev. Gentry at the College Church and find that she is interested in the job. However, I cannot be sure until Monday when I shall have a chance to show her the job and discuss it with her as to whether she will be able to do it. At least it gives me a slight ray of hope. I shall keep you informed.

I just got my student enrollment list for the second semester of this school year at Taylor yesterday. I am shocked to find that I have a total enrollment in my classes of 338 students—the largest I have ever had in my life. In addition to that I have promised to help them again at Marion College. Consequently I may have around 400 students enrolled in my classes for a total next semester. Here I was beginning to wonder if my popularity might be fading in these latter years! I do not really know how to account for such classes. I have one four hour course with an enrollment of 180 student.

We had E. Stanley Jones for Religion Forum all day yesterday. What a blessing he was to us. What a tremendous man of faith! I have heard him several times, but never better or even so good as he is now at 85 years of age. It is amazing what God can do and does do with some people. Where are the rest of us in the service of God?

One the less pleasant side, Dr. Nicholson wrote me something of his disappointment with the action of the WTS concerning the statement in the Scriptures. I am sorry, but I fear he and perhaps some others tend to be a bit too mechanical in their views on this.

O say, I also need a listing of all the new officers elected, committees, etc. of the WTS at Marion. Please send them with their locations, degrees, etc. and of course addresses. In Him
