## REPORT OF THE PROMOTIONAL SECRETARY

To the Members of The Wesleyan Theological Society:

The duties of the Promotional Secretary are two: participation in the work of the executive committee, especially that of program planning, and other work as possible to promote the society and its annual meeting. The former task was fulfilled by attendance at meetings of the executive committee after last year's annual meeting, at the Christian Holiness Association annual convention and here again at this meeting.

Moving and changing positions as well as a difficult work situation during the last year unfortunately prevented some intended promotional efforts, especially general press releases after last year's meeting and before this one. A special news report, however, was prepared at the request of Christianity Today. Unfortunately, but somewhat characteristically, my report was radically rewritten before publication with the result of changing nuance and emphasizing matters that I had not. Also, I attempted to feature the work of the society in an essay on the Holiness and Pentecostal Churches for the Christian Century. Here again specific information about the Journal was cut in the office before publication for reasons of space limitations. In addition to such more formal promotion, I have continued to correspond with those requesting information, to seek new members among various contacts, and to otherwise promote the society.
