## Papers of the 2003 Annual Meeting of the Wesleyan Theological Society

The <u>Spring 2004 issue</u> of the <u>Wesleyan Theological Journal</u> will carry a selection of edited papers presented at the 2003 annual meeting of the Wesleyan Theological Society. All authors of papers presented at this 2003 meeting are encouraged to submit them for formal consideration. Papers will <u>not be considered</u> unless they are submitted by their authors to the <u>WTJ</u> Editor following this 2003 annual meeting, but <u>no later than April 20, 2003</u>.

The WTS's Editorial Committee will meet in May, 2003, to offer evaluation and suggestions to the Editor concerning the articles to be published from among those submitted. Only papers submitted by April 20, 2003, will be considered in this committee meeting.

Submissions may be made to the Editor <u>by email attachment</u> by April 20, 2003 (this gives time for any desired editing by the author after presentation at this meeting). Send <u>by email attachment</u> (saved in "rich text") to the *WTJ* Editor. His mailing address is:
