

# First Quarterly Conference

Jan. 4, 1947

Report of the Woman's Society of Christian Service,  
Wesley Memorial Church.

As the Society's year does not run concurrent with the Conference year, this report will include the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter's work of the Society - from October thru December. Work that has been done since the close of the Conference year in October.

During this last quarter one member was added to the roll of the Society making the total enrollment 204. Membership in the Guild remains at 50, the same as last quarter.

Money sent to the Conference Treasurer this quarter totalled \$523.51. \$65.01 of this amount was contributed by the Wesleyan Guild. One Baby Life Membership was secured during the quarter; Week of Prayer Offerings totalled \$100.00; \$36.00 was collected for the Church Emergency; and \$5.00 was sent to the Korean Kindergarten.

In addition to supporting the usual projects, members gave \$249.48 thru the Christian Social Relations Committee.

For 4 consecutive Tuesday mornings in November 50 women representing Trinity, Calvary and Lakewood, ~~churches~~ and Duke Memorial churches met at Duke Memorial to study the text "We who are American". This study, ably taught, by Mrs. A. H. Boland counted as a jurisdictional course. 45 of the 50 women enrolled attended all sessions and completed required supplementary assignments.

In October the Society co-operated with Dr. Glenn in sending out 125 letters as a follow-up to the religious census taken in the city. In these letters persons who had expressed a preference for Duke Memorial Church as well as those who had expressed no preference were invited to attend the church and the Society's meetings.

During the quarter members of the Society helped to serve a dinner to the members of the Board of Stewards.

Officers for 1944 were elected at the November meeting, and were installed at the Dec. meeting by the District Sect. Secretary, Mrs. A. H. Boland.
