

The Board of Christian Education of Duke Memorial Church met on August 30 with seven members present. Mr. Angier presided. The minutes were read and approved.

Mrs. Lee reported on her investigation of outdoor equipment. Fifty five dollars and fifty cents less ten percent would purchase a frame with one swing and two air gliders. A motion was passed favoring the purchase of this equipment.

A ^{second} letter was sent out about the nursery school and a meeting of parents is planned for next week.

Appreciation for a ^{new} cabinet in the nursery was expressed. Mr. Angier will see about balancing boards.

There is a great need for additional seasons in the kindergarten department; especially there are too many children in the nursery during church.

Betsy ^{Pop Lee} reported a very enjoyable Javaluoka trip. She and Katherine ^{Jette} back took intermediate work.

Mr. Boddie reported the heating plant almost complete.

Mr. Wilson led in a discussion of the need for and possibility of Biblical instruction. The Board passed a motion recommending some action and asking Mr. Wilson to present the matter to the Board of Stewards with the recommendation that a committee be appointed to study the matter.

A discussion of planning Wednesday night for church night with different groups meeting was held.

Mr. Angier reported a balance of \$228.20 on hand with one quarter's literature bill soon due.

Mr. Whitford reported that he was working on the year's statistical report. He called attention to Promotion Sunday and reported that attendance was off somewhat.

Mr. Boddie reported that the opera chairs would perhaps be taken out of the intermediate department and folding stool chairs used.

The Board ^{approved and} authorized the sending of letters to teachers expressing appreciation for their service and requesting their continuance for another year, also a letter to parents about Promotional Day.

Also the plan to send a letter to the church membership with stewardship opportunities ^{listed} was approved. The pastor, superintendent and director were to confer.

The possibility of a class for training teachers was discussed.

The Fall Walker's Conference was set for September 27.

The meeting was closed with prayer by Professor Wilson.
