Dear Sir:-

In explanation of the items omitted or included in Mr. Underwood's proposal and contract, will say that the item of \$600. covers the cost of three flexifold doors permanently omitted.

One closet has been permanently omitted from the Primary Department toilet.

The four closets and four basins under choir loft are omitted at \$220. Not being included in either option will appear as Option No. 3 when ordered at above price, the sewerage and waste pipes being placed under present contract.

All screen and door glass for interior of Sunday School department are included in contract but not the leaded glass of fan lights over alcoves.

All exterior glass of basement windows and doors are omitted.

Changes ordered January 13th by Board will be made with such additions to or deductions from contract price as the cost of such changes may make.
