I have now completed my translation of your critical reply to my analysis of obedience, which as I indicated in my recent letter to you The Westminster Press has requested that it might appear as an appendix to my discussion which is soon to be published tentatively under the title Radical Obedience: A Study of the Ethics of Rudolf Bultmann.

If you so desire I would welcome you to check over my translation and please do not hesitate to make any suggestions which would bring the English sentences closer in line with your intention.
