Here are the suggestions for decorating the Ladies' bathrooms in Education Building and behind the sanctuary.

Education Bldg. bath:

1. Replace the odd ceiling tile and clean ceiling - a job for you / Sam to complete, please.
2. Clean floor, especially the grout between tiles. Jenny from Piedmont Decorators will get an estimate for this. I have also spoken to Sam Keel who said he could take care of that.
3. Using the current blue stall drap as a backing, hang a muted stripe or muted floral design curtain - gray, pinks to tie together all the existing room colors (Same material for both bathrooms)
4. Small chair (hopefully a wicker) placed generally where the chairs are currently in each bathroom. Is there another chair like the one in the Bathroom behind sanctuary? That one is small and could be used ^{in place} in case wicker ones are not located

Bathroom, too

5. Sponge paint the walls of Education Building - gray with soft pink and a lighter gray sponged on top.

Caroline Sasser & I hope to find someone who can do this painting; Ben Nixon can recommend a painter

6. Two oval mirrors hung over sinks in Education Building bathroom (if we can locate such)

7. Small picture - floral or landscape on wall to left of long mirror on wall of Ed. Bldg. bathroom.

8. Small picture on wall over shelf in "new stall" of Education Bldg.

9. Pictures on wall with towel holder in Sanctuary bathroom, or 2 complementary pictures on the wall beside door from hallway in Sanctuary bath

10. Repaint inside of door to Sanctuary Bathroom to ~~either~~ match existing woodwork, if there is any existing paint. Do you know if there is any?

11. Repaint walls of Sanctuary bathroom in a soft blush color, not as crucial as other bathroom walls.

I have been promised monies from Council on ministries and Ben has told me to let him know if we need more funds. At this point, if you could be responsible for:

1. Cleaning ceiling of Education Bldg bath and replacing the one odd tile
2. Locate a second chair to match the small chair in the Sanctuary bath (in case we don't find wicker ones)
3. ~~Get painter at later date for~~ the Repaint inside of door to match woodwork in Sanctuary bath - if such paint exists.
4. Get painter at later date for Sanctuary bath ... This painting is low down on the list!
